The camp will begin Saturday afternoon, August 10th, and end the following Friday morning, August 16th.

Staff at our camp include Youth Activity Coordinators (YACs), recreation staff, counsellors, food service professionals, and camp nurses.



Early bird registration is **\$700 per camper** (\$800 for non-SFL affiliates). After April 30, registration is \$800 (\$900 for non-SFL affiliates.

Full payment <u>must</u> accompany completed registration in order to qualify.

Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost – check with your union local. Arrangement for payment by the union is the responsibility of the camper's parent(s)/guardian(s).

Limited scholarships are available. Our goal is to ensure no one is excluded because of cost.
