Grievance Committee

In you CBA it is outlined the steps and process to follow. If you encounter a situation where you feel your CBA is not being followed, we encourage you to reach out to your Shop Steward, Member of your Executive, or any member for information moving forward. We encourage every member to work with Supervisors, Human Resources and the union to help resolve any issue, if able to before initiating the grievance procedure.

There are grievance forms available for completing electronically on our website. Please download, you will be asked to complete the "UNION FACT SHEET" for Union only, which is then used to complete the grievance report with a Shop Steward. If you don't have access to download the forms, reach out to your Shop Steward or Executive and someone can provide these forms to you.

Union Assistance Plan

This plan is free to sign up, you complete the beige coloured card designating a beneficiary in the event of your passing this designated beneficiary will be issued a cheque from your local for \$2,500.00 – See example of card completed on our website. If at any time you wish to update and make changes, contact your executive and another card will be made available to you for completion.

We are always looking for members to become involved in any area from Shop Stewards, OH&S, Grievance Committee and so much more. If you are wanting to become involved, please contact your local executive. Training is paid and provided for based on availability with reimbursement of costs. (Mileage, Meals, Hotel, Cab etc.)
